- \* Chest pain can be relieved with pain medication.
- \* Coughing up blood may require surgery.
- \* Difficulty breathing may require mechanical ventilation.

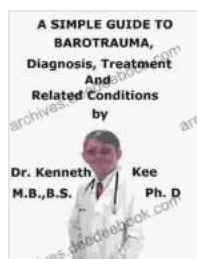
## Related Conditions

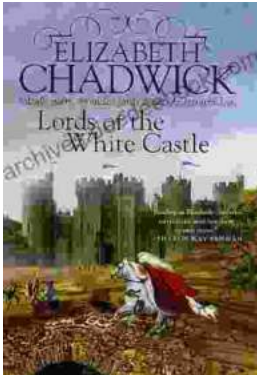

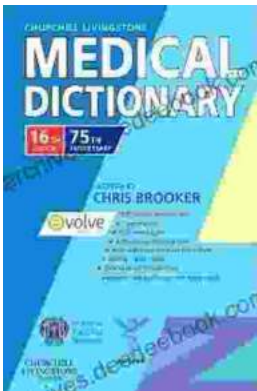
