

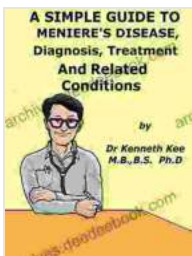
# Simple Guide to Meniere's Disease: Diagnosis, Treatment, and Related Conditions

\* Medications to reduce dizziness and nausea \* Hearing aids to improve hearing \* Surgery to drain fluid from the inner ear

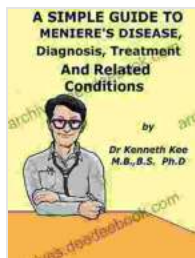

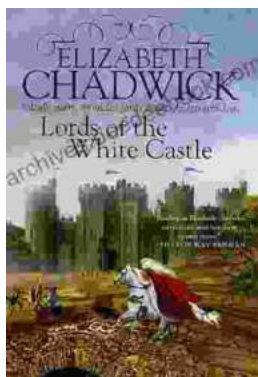

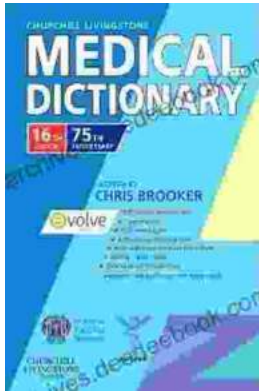
